Non-smoking Policy

The Bridge Education Centre recognises that:

- People are entitled to breathe air unpolluted by tobacco smoke.
- Passive smoking can be hazardous to health.
- Environmental tobacco smoke causes discomfort and pervades hair, clothing and furnishings.
- The majority of the population are non-smokers.
- There is growing public demand for smoke-free areas; now with legal requirements and consequences..
- Ventilation alone does not adequately protect against the effects of environmental tobacco smoke.

In recognition of the above:

- As all school and local authority sites, The Bridge Education Centre is a designated non-smoking site. Consequently, all smoking is not permitted on the premises/site.
- All pupils will be actively involved in a programme of smoking awareness.
- No e cigarettes are permitted in any County Council Building site.
